DROM ist the title of Kohelet 3's latest CD-production that is due to be released in October 2012. In Romanes DROM means "The Path". The long-lasting musical companions of the band Kohelet 3 focus on songs of Eastern Europe's great nomadic cultures: the Roma and the Eastern European Jews. Another point of key aspect is the music of Bohdan's homeland: of Ukraine.

Apart from selected texts from Ewa DROM features a genuine musical experiment: After the shared experience of a travel to Ukraine, Ewa and Bohdan invited their eldest son Janko to compose contemporary, electronic music for their upcoming CD-production, together with his duo-partner Eva Poepplein that should combine elements of the journey with field-recordings of Ukrainian folk-songs and blend them into a unique esthetical entity.

Two different musical worlds meet and create for a moment of music that is both Eastern European folklore and contemporary electronic composition.
